## MERCY RULE FOR HIGH WATER USAGE

If you experience exceptionally high water usage due to a leak or plumbing problem, the Mercy Rule is available. It is a one time credit on one water bill in the Sewer and Debt Service charges

Once the billing clerk receives your letter (as described in #1), it will be submitted to the Village Manager for his consideration. Upon his approval, you will receive an adjusted bill in the mail.

## **RESOLUTION NO. 97-11**

BE IT RESOLVED by the council of Granville, Ohio, that:

WHEREAS, occasionally an excessive amount of water and wastewater usage is registered due to a property owner's faulty plumbing or a mishap occurs which results in a financial hardship on the utility customer, the Village Manager may use his/her discretion to invoke a "Mercy Rule" under the following guidelines:

- 1. Customer must notify the Village in writing of the problem and action taken to correct the problem. (Attn: Water billing clerk)
- 2. Customer will be billed in full for the large usage and a credit will be given after all guidelines have been met.
- 3. Customer will pay the full dollar amount of the water portion of the bill.
- 4. Customer will pay the average metered usage for the previous twelve months on the sewer and debt service portion of the bill.
- 5. The Manager may invoke the "Mercy Rule" only one time, for only one month's billing period, every five years, per account.
- 6. This "Mercy Rule" shall not and cannot not be applied retroactively to incidents occurring prior to December 1, 1996.
