RESOLUTION NO. 2023-47

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE MANAGER TO PREPARE AND SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO PARTICIPATE IN THE OHIO PUBLIC WORKS COMMISSION (OPWC) STATE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM(S), TO EXECUTE CONTRACTS AS REQUIRED

WHEREAS, the State Capital Improvement Program and the Local Transportation Program both provide financial assistance to political subdivisions for capital improvements in public infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Granville is planning to make capital improvements, namely: the Boosted Zone 1 Water Main; and

WHEREAS, the infrastructure improvements are considered to be a priority need for the Village and is a qualified project under the OPWC programs.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Village Council of Granville, Ohio that:

Section I: The Village Manager is hereby authorized to apply to the OPWC for funding for the Project described above.


Section II: The Village Manager is further authorized to enter into any agreements as may be necessary and appropriate for obtaining this financial assistance.
